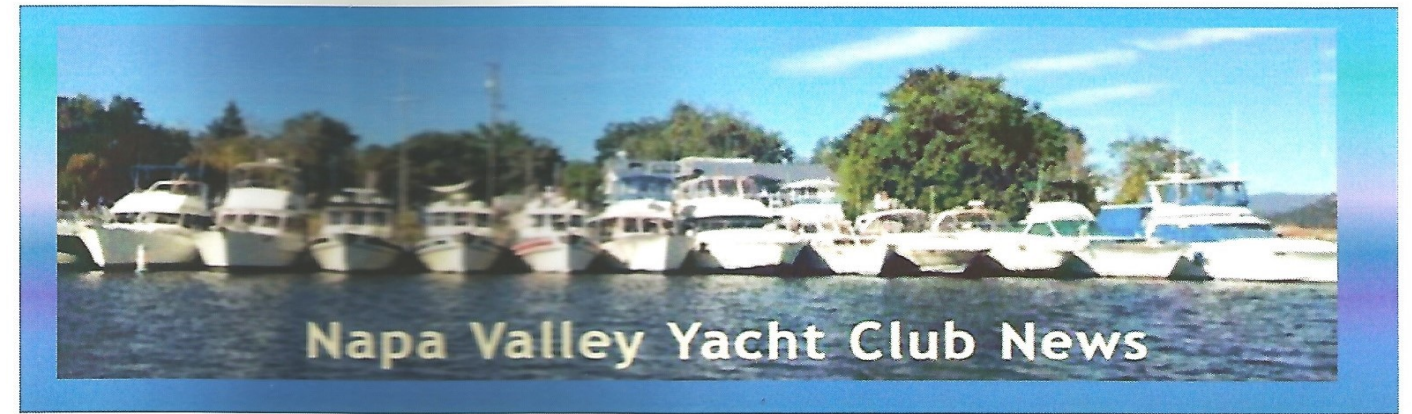

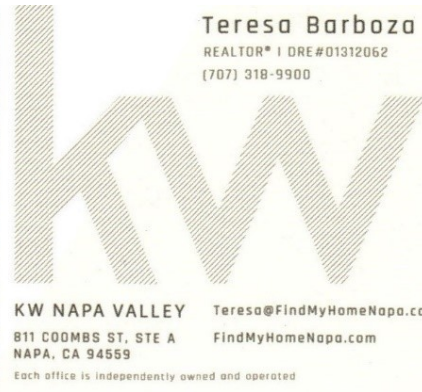

Our club's community outreach programs are going well, with the second annual Camille Creek Student Cruise and BBQ which was held May 30<sup>th</sup>. These are kids from Camille Creek High School, which is run under the direction of Napa Juvenile Hall system. This was the second year for the event, again organized by our member and initiator of the program, Gloria Atkinson. Participants included 39 students and five instructors from the school, and 18 volunteer club members, including the captains of six boats, kitchen and BBQ grilling and cleanup teams. The tour headed north to downtown Napa, then south to the Kennedy Park launch ramp. It was a first time on the water for many of the students, and a memorable experience for them. We hope to continue the student cruise as an annual event.

Another of our outreach programs relating to water recreation and youth boating is our annual "Paddle day". We are looking forward to this event which is hosted by our club and sponsored by the Ohana Wa' a Outrigger Conoe Club . Their youth programs include teaching paddling, safety on the water and appreciation of the Napa River. The Paddle day event is scheduled for September 18<sup>th</sup>.

One of our biggest events of each year is the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Decorated Boat Parade followed by a BBQ and live music on our deck. Entitled "Diamond on the Dock, this event featured live professional performer of Neil Diamond style music, Jack Wright. This is the second year we've had Wright at our traditional 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade event and, as with last year, was enjoyed with much enthusiasm by our members and guests. Many thanks to Gloria Atkinson and many other volunteers who worked tirelessly to organize this very successful event.

Coming up soon is our annual "Poker Run," scheduled for August 11th SAVE THE DATE and the Commodore's Cruise to Benicia scheduled for August 16-18. The Benicia Yacht Club has dinners on both Friday and Saturday nights and on Sunday a jazz festival starting at noon. We are invited to attend all of these events. The BYC is one of our favorite cruise-out destinations, and the marina has a fuel dock, public rest rooms with showers, and is a short distance from downtown Benicia. 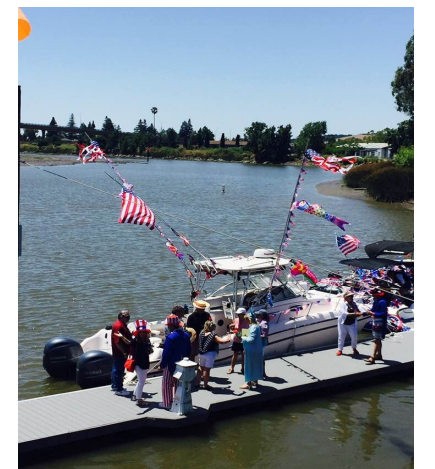
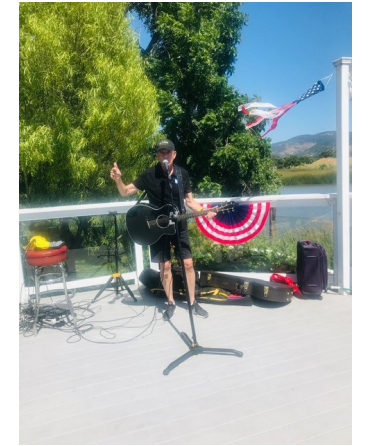
